WHAT?

“Breaking barriers: Unlock the inclusion gate” is a youth exchange work on four main topics: disability, inclusion, human rights and interculturality through non-formal and informal education.

In this youth exchange we are going to create activities about these topics, learn international sign system and braille, as well as analyze the kind of learning and self-learning methods. Our participants will be also involved in creating video and theatre about the main topics of this youth exchange.

The main objectives of this project are:

- To support the strengthening of social dialogue among young people from different backgrounds, through intercultural understanding.
- To work on the acceptance of diversity and inclusion that breaks down prejudices and stereotypes among young people.
- To know more about the different types of sensory disability and how the sensory disability affects the relationships and the environment of who has it.
- To promote an active citizenship among young people through reflection and self-analysis of learning and recognition of individual competencies and teamwork.

WHO IS PARTICIPATING?

The **participant's countries** in this project are **Estonia** (Seiklejate Vennaskond), **Italy** (Per Esemplio), **Portugal** (Associação Check-in Cooperação e desenvolvimento), **Netherlands** (Euromove) and **Spain** (Asociación “Europa 2020”).

PARTICIPANTS PROFILE

Young people between **18 and 30 years old** with an active attitude in youth participation, with special interest in learning from other cultures.

We will prioritize young people, with economic barriers, cultural, social and geography difficulties.

The overall group of participants are **30 people: 5 participants + 1 leader per country**

WHEN?

11 – 20 December, 2017

WHERE?

This project will take place in **Puente Genil**, city located at South of Cordoba, in the center of Andalusia.



HOW?

The **methodology** used to perform this type of activity is participatory, dynamic and fostering creativity. For this purpose, we will do role play, theatre forum, debates, energizers, presentations, artistic activities...

HOW MUCH?

This project will be implemented within the framework of Erasmus + Programme of the European Commission (K1). Hence, all costs related to food, accommodation and activities will be paid in full. The **travel costs** are financed by European Commission, attending to the programme rules according to **distance calculator**.
